Thread macaroni with wool to make a necklace or bracelet.

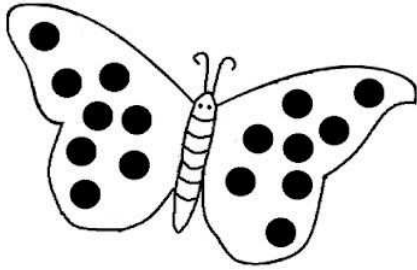
