- Connect the dots

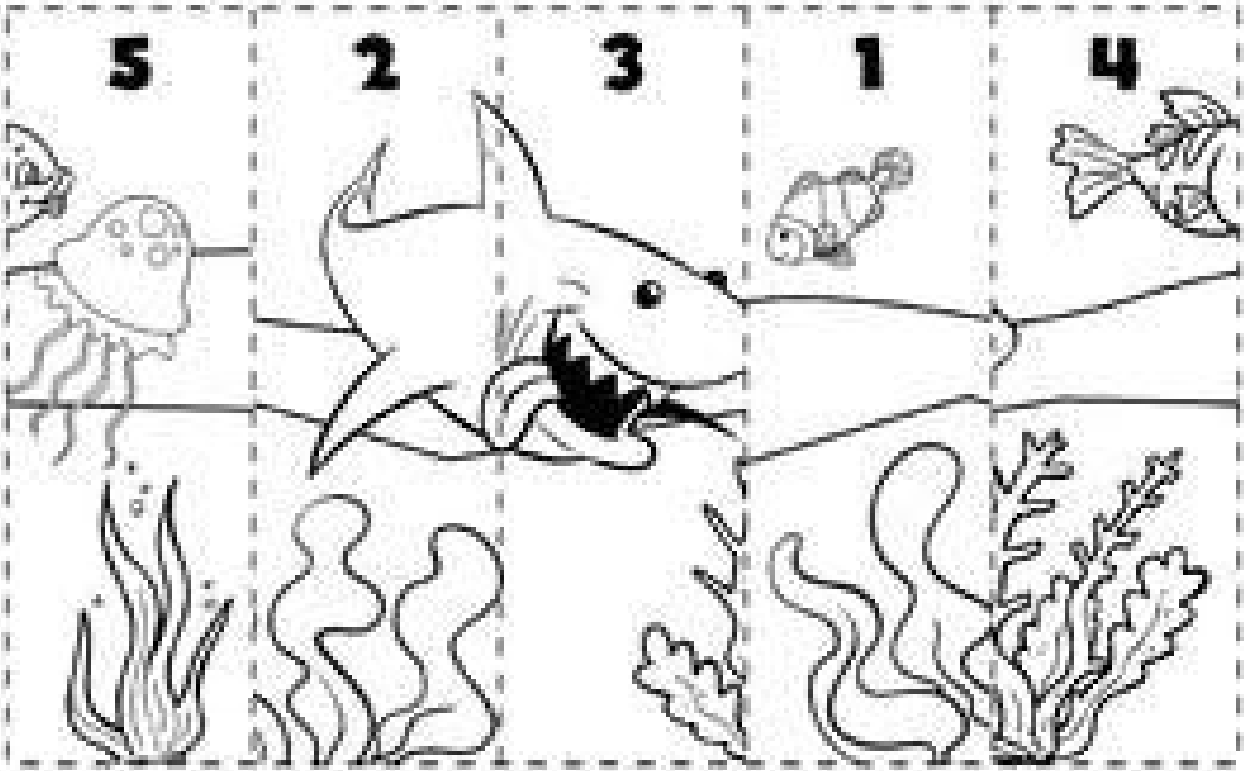
