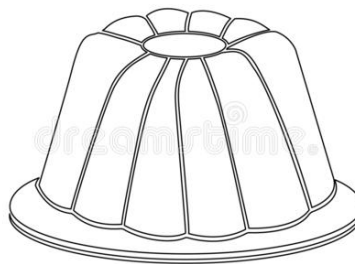
#### English

#### Mathematics

##### Numbers:

Ask your child to count out any number of objects. It is important that they follow the instruction the first time it is given.

Give your child two piles of macaroni. Ask them which group bigger and which group is smaller. For example: Put 7 macaroni's in one group and 3 in the other. The group of 7 is bigger.

Practise ordinal numbers: Put four objects next to each other in a line. Ask your child what position they are in. For example: scissors, glass, apple and pen. The scissors are first, the glass is second, the apple is third and the pen is fourth or last.

#### Life Skills

##### General knowledge:

Discuss the sense of taste with your child. Some things taste nice and others not so nice. Name a few things that you like to taste and some that you dislike tasting.

##### Gross motor skills:

Practise bouncing and catching a tennis ball with one hand. Alternate left and right hands.

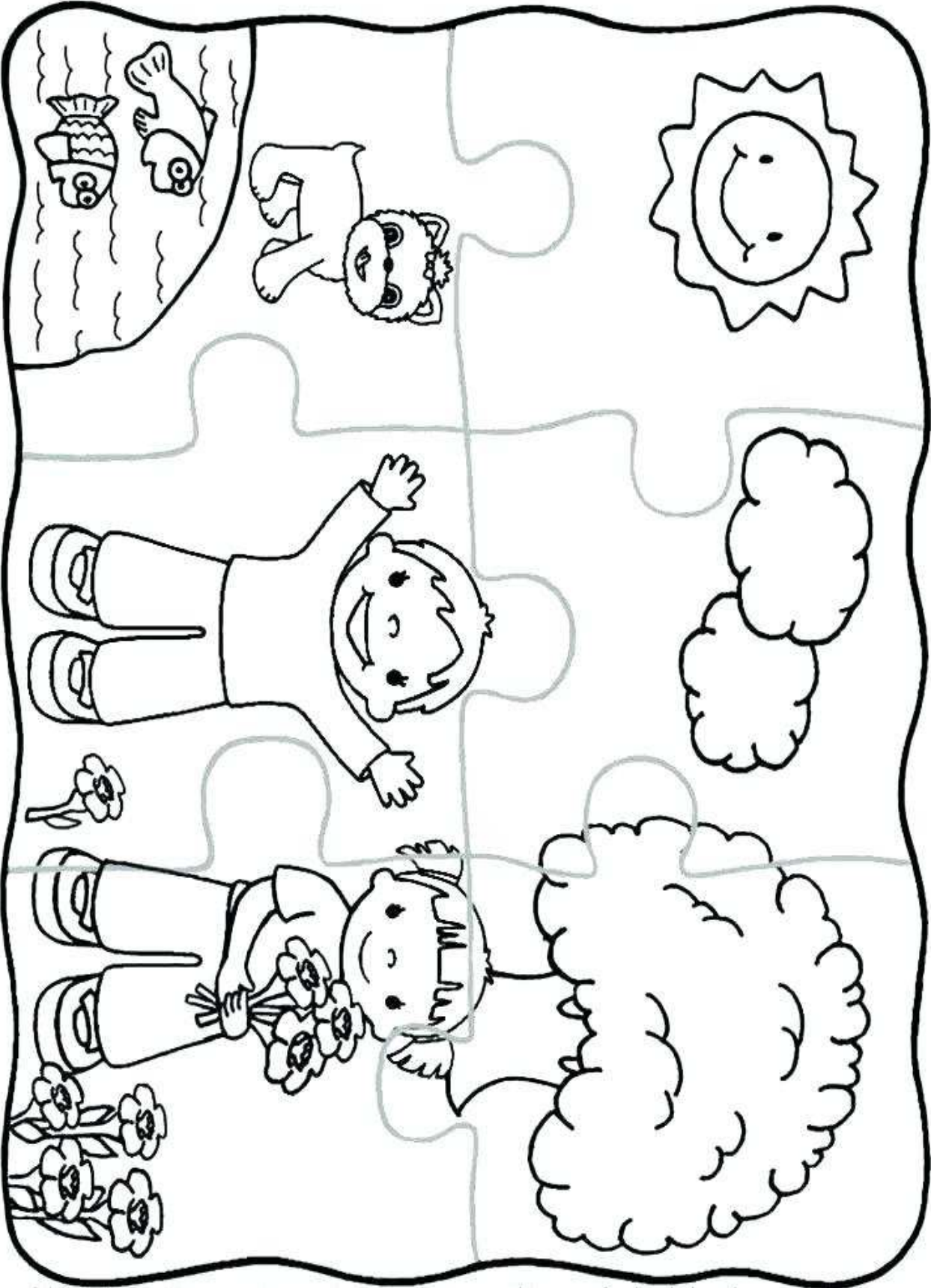
