Poem:

Practice my five senses poem. If your child is comfortable with this poem you can add some actions to match the words.

Forming letters:

Ask your child to form certain letters with their whole body. For example, make a 'l' with your body or make a 'w' with your body.

Give your child playdough and ask them to form letters using the playdough. Give them an example if they struggle.

**Mathematics**

Numbers:

Ask your child to count to 20.

Ask your child which number come before/ after/ between. For example, which number comes after 3? Which number comes before 10? Which number is between 1 and 3?

Patterns:

Give your child a piece of paper and some crayons. Ask them to make their own pattern using two different colors or pictures. Once they are comfortable with this, they can make a pattern using three colors/ pictures or more.

**Life Skills**

Games and activities:

Play any animal sound from your phone and let your child guess which animal it was. If they answer correctly, they should act like that specific animal. Then guess the next sound.

- Story sequencing: The Little Red Hen

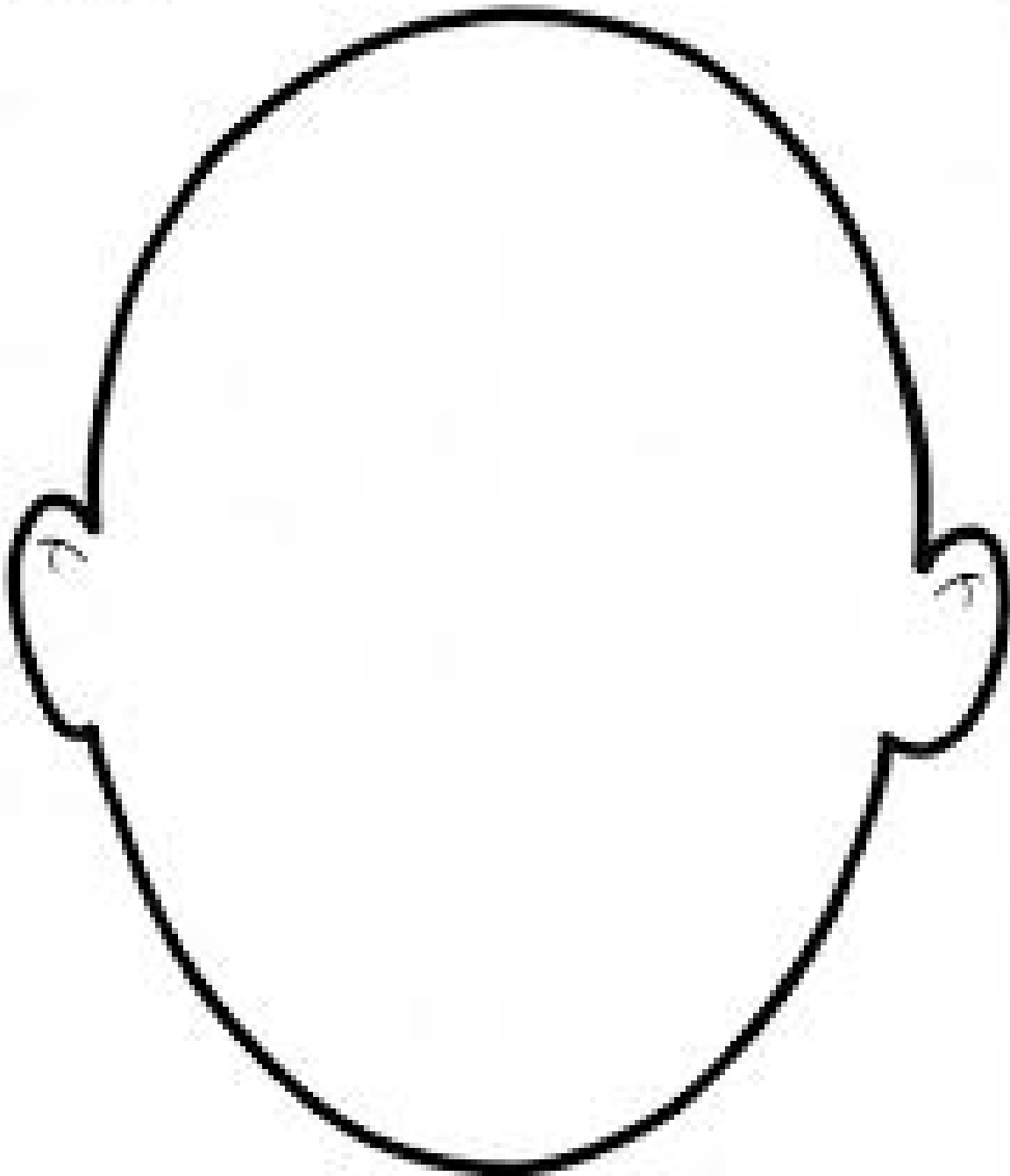

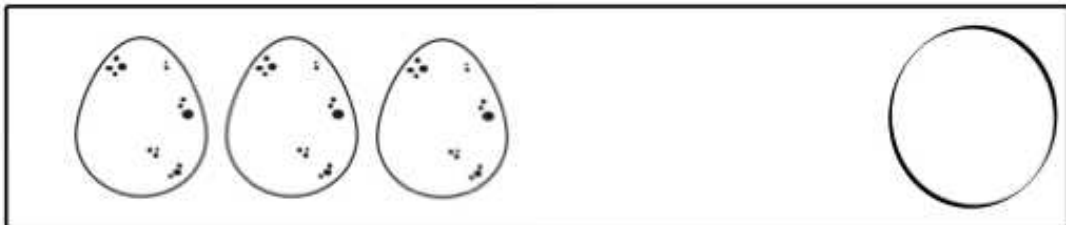
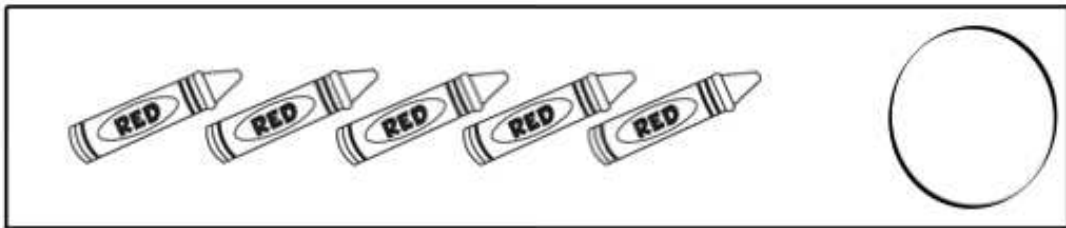
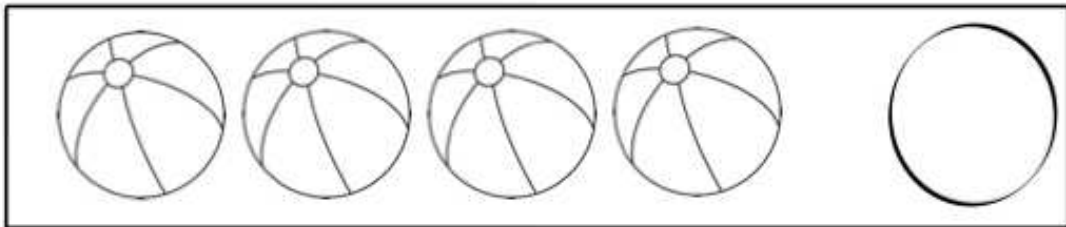
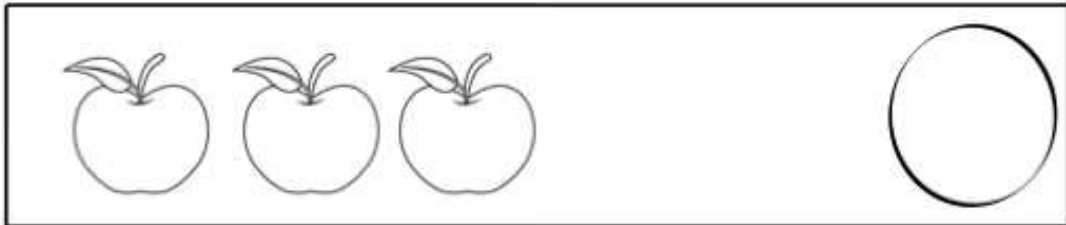


**My face:**
