Nursery Rhyme:

Keep practicing Three Blind Mice. Once your child is confident with this nursery rhyme, you can add some actions to make it more fun to say.

Mathematics

Sorting:

Use a pack of bicycle playing cards. Let your child sort it into two piles: black and red.

Let your child sort it into four piles: Hearts, Diamonds, Spades and Clubs. If you don't have cards, use different coloured mixed beans or beads.

Life Skills

Computers:

Let your child start with Section E from the 'Preschool' section. Spend about 30 minutes on computers each week.

Body parts:

Let your child do the following movements:

- Put your nose on your hand
- Put your ear on your shoulder
- Put your hands on your back
- Put your elbow on your knee
- Put your wrist on your heel
- Put your toes on your toes

Fine motor skills:

You will need a sponge and toothpicks.

Let your child push the toothpicks into the sponge using their thumb and each finger in turn. For example: Use thumb and pointy finger for first toothpick, use thumb and middle finger for second toothpick, use thumb and ring finger for third toothpick, etc. Do this with left and right hand until all toothpicks are used up.

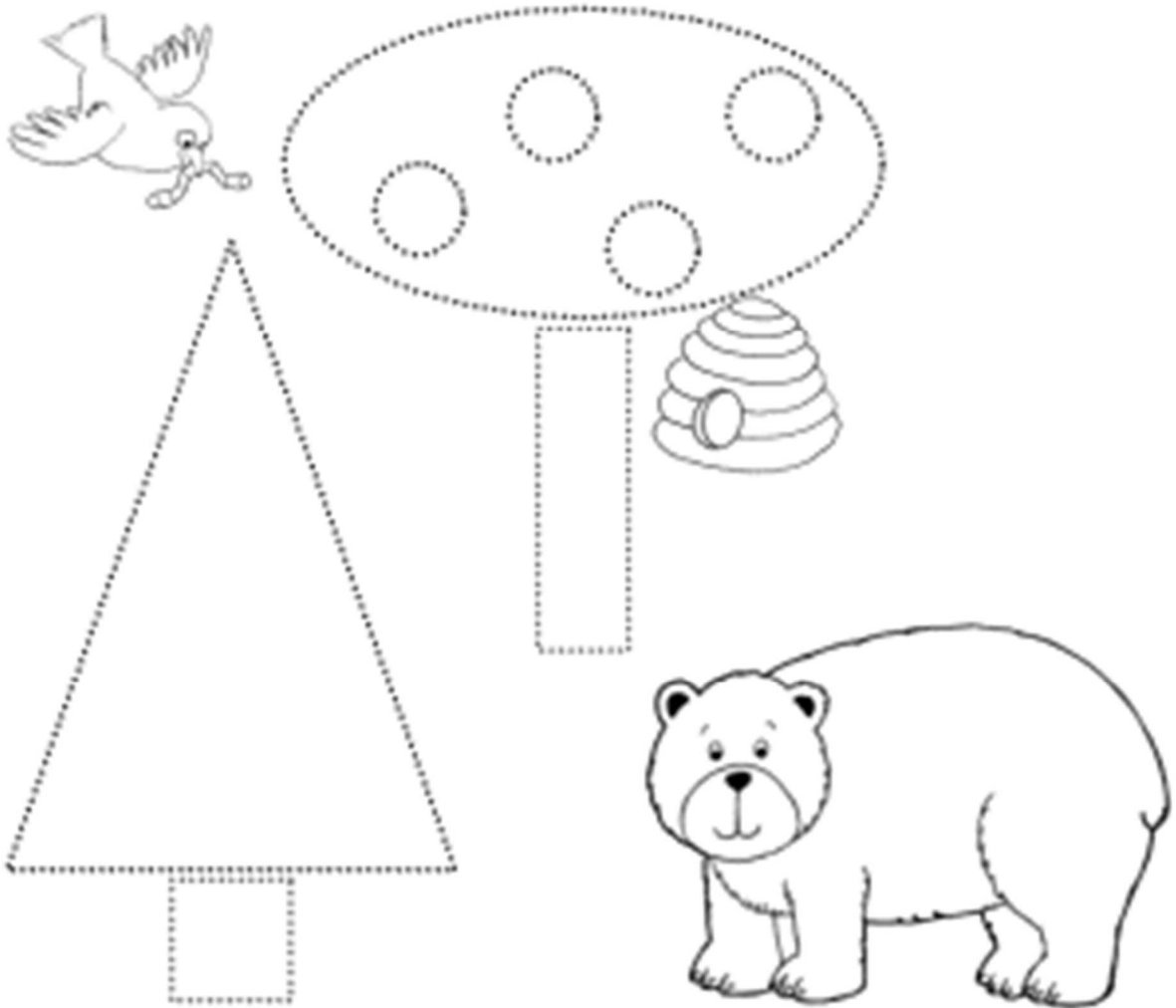
