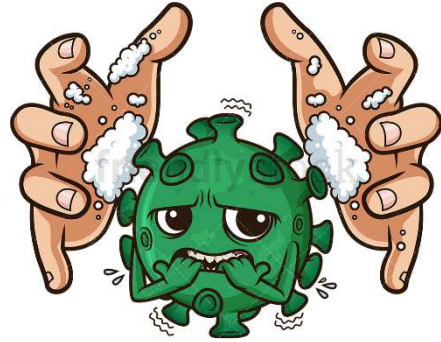
Poem:

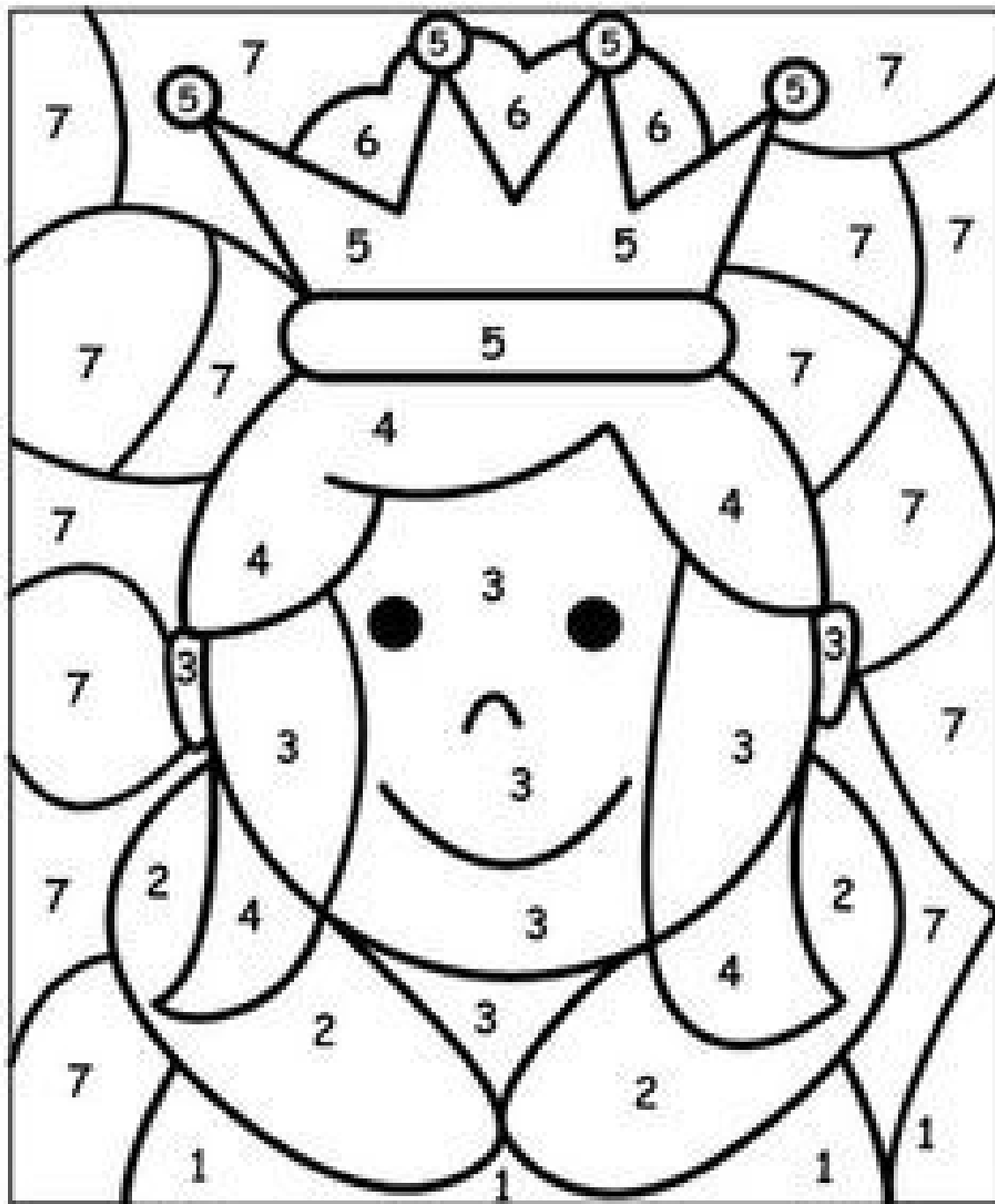
