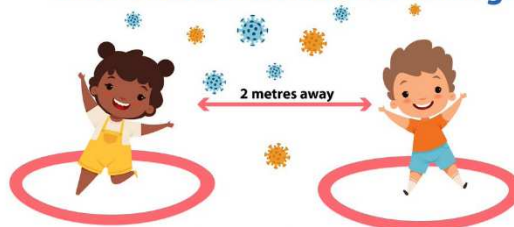
Virus:

General knowledge:

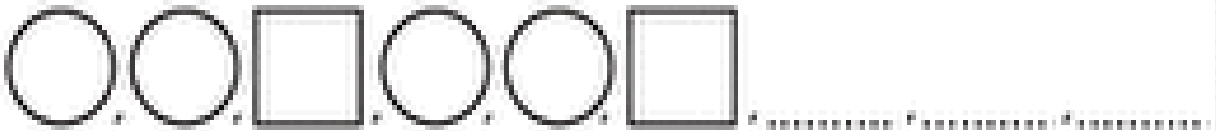
