Numbers:

Practise writing numbers 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.

**Life Skills**

General knowledge:

Discuss the sense of sound. Ask your child to use their sense of sound to listen for things around them.

Ask them what they hear.

Introduce the 'p' sound.

Look for any object at home that starts with the letter 'p'.

Let your child practice forming this letter with playdough or mud. Let them draw the letter in the sand or paint it with water on the stones.

Gross motor skills:

Carry out the following instructions:

- Stand behind the chair
- Stand in front of the table
- Sit on top of your table
- Lie under your table
- Put your left hand up
- Lift up your right leg
- Stand on the right-hand side of the table
- Stand on the left-hand side of the table

Fine motor skills:

Use a wet face cloth and let your child wring out the water. Do this several times.

Explain to your child that this exercise will help to strengthen their wrist muscles.

Give your child a clean piece of paper.


Read the instructions one at a time.
