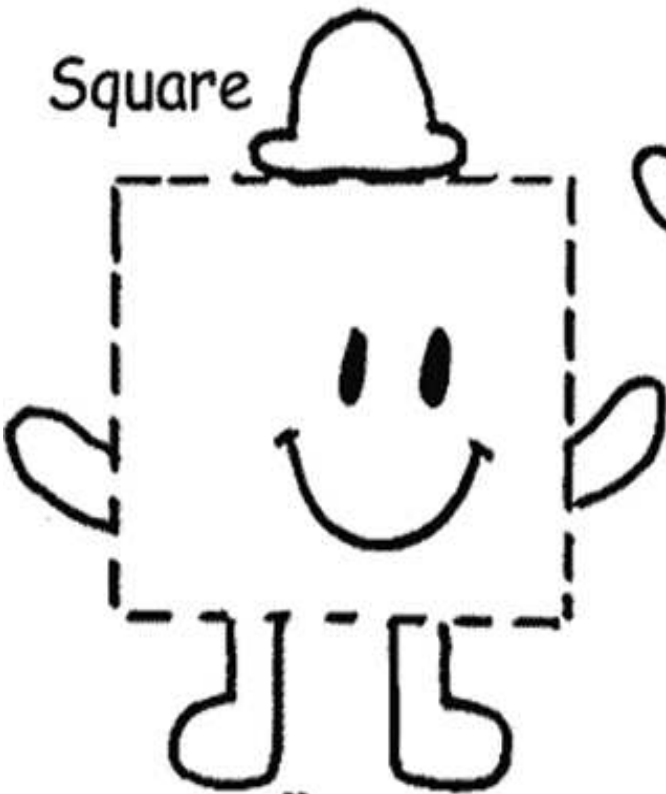

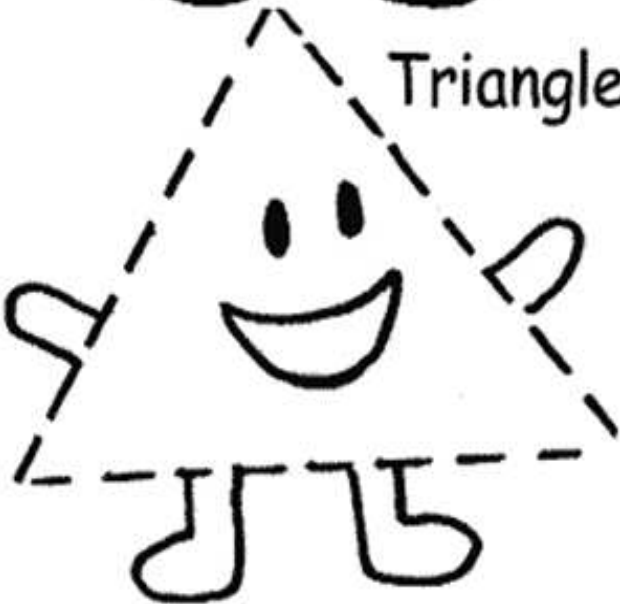

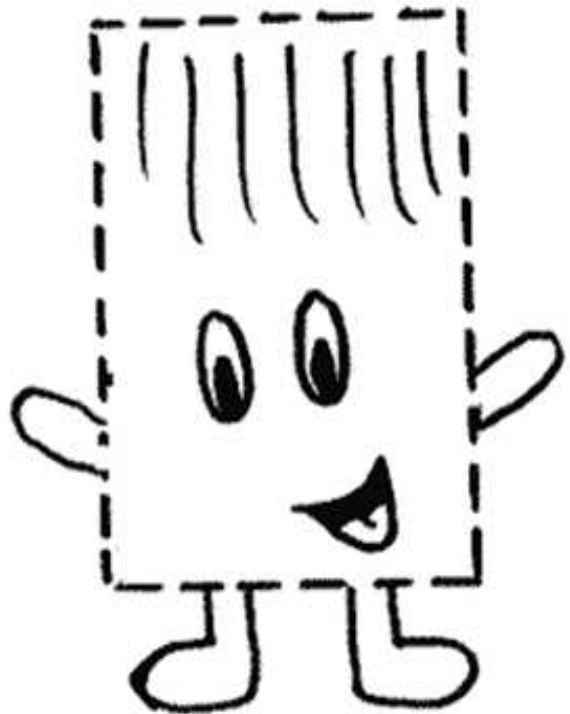
Circle
