Life Skills

General knowledge:

Discuss the sense of smell. Ask your child what body part they use to smell things with. Some smells are pleasant, and others are not. Ask your child to name some things they can smell.

Look for any object at home that starts with the letter 'd'.

Name a few things that start with the 'd' sound.

Gross motor skills:

Practise throwing and catching a tennis ball with one hand only. Alternate between your left and right hand.

Fine motor skills:

Watch the pencil grip video posted on the school website. Hold your pencil correctly and practice writing your name. Remember to only write the first letter of your name with a capital letter.
